THE FIRST PALM SUNDAY

The crowd that went ahead  
and the others that came behind raised the shout:

All **Hosanna to the Son of David!**  
**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.**  
**Hosanna in the highest!** Matthew 21.9

PROCESSION via St James Terrace & St James Road (if dry)  
though the Undercroft and Lady Chapel (if wet)

*If remaining in church, **please stand** as the procession enters  
and turn to face the back of church.*
