BLESSING:




PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER [E]

Lift up your hearts.

All **We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

Father, you made the world ... and angels praising you and singing

Choir Holy, holy, holy Lord...
