



**Casualties of War** To mark the Centenary of Armistice Day, Richard Roddis and friends present a commemorative programme of songs and readings. Rather than focussing on the conflict, this recital highlights the talent of the British composers and poets who like so many others left to fight but never returned. It also celebrates the rural landscape of England which they held so dear and which they died defending.

Composers: George Butterworth, Gerald Finzi, W Denis Browne and Ernest Farrar. Poets: Edward Thomas, Rupert Brooke, Wilfred Owen, Francis Ledwidge. Plus straddling the two art-forms Ivor Gurney who survived.
