

ST MARTIN'S DAY MARCH will take place on Saturday 9 November at 5.30pm with a short service and a lantern walk around the cathedral followed by refreshments. This service will be attended by members from the German School, which is linked to De Montfort University. St. Martin is a very popular Saint in Germany and Holland in particular. In medieval times up until the time of the Reformation there was a patronal statue of St. Martin that used to be paraded through the streets of Leicester on certain occasions. St. Martin's day is 11th November.
